



MAGS Swimming Club Swim Meet Policy

Team morale is of paramount importance. Almost all decisions will be guided by what is best for the total squad. It is our belief that discipline, well earned pride and a high degree of selflessness contribute to achieving desirable morale. Remember the individual is an important member of every team, but at no time will a decision be made that will detrimentally affect the well being or morale of our squad.

Swimming success is decided on the little things, thus meticulous attention must be paid to the details of the programme. A 'winning attitude' among Coaches, Management, Swimmers and Parents is mandatory.

Entering Swim Meets

Level 3 swim meets

ALL swimmers need to discuss their entries with the coach.

1st time swimmer 13 under

Maximum entry of

1. 4x25m events **or**
2. 3x25m and 1x 50m event **or**
3. 1x25m and 1x100m event

There after

- 1 4x25m and 1x 100m event **or**
- 2 4x25m and 2x 50m events **or**
- 3 3x50m events **or**
- 4 2x50m and 1x100m event **or**
- 5 2x 100m event (if the swimmer is genuinely aiming for a level 2 time)

Level 2 swim meets

ALL swimmers need to discuss their entries with the coach.

ALL swimmers are to enter the 200 IM events unless instructed otherwise by the coach.

Entry per session

- 1 1x50 and 2x 100 events **or**
- 2 1x50m and 1x200m event **or**
- 3 2x50m and 1x 400m event

Level 1 swim meets

ALL swimmers need to discuss their entries with the coach.

ALL 16years and under swimmers are to enter the 200 IM events unless instructed otherwise by the coach.

Entry per session

- 1 2x 100 or 200m events **or**
- 2 2x 50m and 1x 100m event **or**
- 3 1x50m and 1x 400m event (if agreed by the coach)

Regional, National and International events

ALL swimmers need to discuss their entries with the coach.



Swimmers Code of Conduct

Swimmers at all times will conduct themselves in a manner befitting a club representative.

- a) No performance enhancing drugs to be used by swimmers.
- b) Swimmers while on tour or in camp will not possess, consume, administer, purchase or supply legally prohibited substances of any kind.
- c) Will not participate in unlawful acts or wilful damage to another person's property.
- d) All telephone/cell phone calls will be screened. Cell phones must be handed to management on arrival to swim meets and camps.
- e) Banter and team chants will be acceptable however individuals must be respectful to other Clubs, all swimmers and people officiating at the event.
- f) No swimmers will transport other swimmers unless they have had 2 years driving experience on a full driver's license and parental permission has been granted for both the driver and the passengers.
- g) All road rules and laws must be adhered to under all circumstances.
- h) No boys in girl's rooms or no girls in boy's rooms, meetings will take place in communal areas.
- i) Loyalty is a must towards each other, only positive statements about other swimmers.
- j) Any costs involved re damage to property, by swimmers, may be at their parent's expense.
- k) Any complaints will be through the appropriate channels.
- l) NO swimmer is to enter a Fly event above 50m unless discussed and agreed to by their coach
- m) Swimmers are to arrive at least 15min prior to the start of the warm up and are expected to support their team for the entire session.
- n) Swimmers wishing to leave the swim meet early or arrive late must inform the coach/manager 48 hours prior to the meet starting in writing via email or letter.

Swimmers Club uniform

Swimmers Club uniform is compulsory and required to be worn for all swim meets when representing MAGS Swimming Club, including Club championships. It is not compulsory for the club uniform to be worn at League events such as the Auckland Swimming League.

The official uniform is:

Required Items

- **MAGSSC Swim Cap**
- **Race Togs** are to be plain black togs (with no other colours). Those swimmers wanting to purchase fast skins may seek dispensation from the Coach before purchase.
- **MAGSSC T-Shirt** (compulsory). No other shirt is permitted.
- **MAGSSC Shorts / Trackpants**
- **MAGSSC Tracksuit**

When receiving awards, the club uniform of Club shirt with shorts/tracksuit pants must be worn with the option of wearing the official club jacket or sweatshirt.
